

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADJUSTMENT OF WATER  
RATES AND CHARGES  
BULLOCK PEN WATER DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that the Bullock Pen Water ("District") has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky ("PSC") seeking approval of revised water rates and non-recurring charges. The District plans to implement the proposed rates upon approval of the PSC.

The average bill based on 4,000 gallons will increase from \$36.73 to \$44.51 an increase of \$7.78 or 21 percent. The minimum bill for 1 inch connections is \$44.51, for 1 1/2 inch connections the minimum bill is \$76.76. The minimum bill for 2 inch connections is \$139.96.
