O R D E R

On February 2, 2010, the Commission entered an Order in which we found that the record of this case was void of any reference that notice of either credit or debit card proposed charges were provided to customers as required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3), and 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8. The Commission ordered:

Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Bullock Pen [Water District] shall file a statement with the Commission attesting to compliance with the regulations as they relate to customer notice of a proposed increase in the credit and debit card rate. If no statement is filed within the set time frame, the Commission shall deem Bullock Pen to have withdrawn its proposed credit and debit card rate.


Bullock Pen has not filed any such statement. Therefore, we deem Bullock Pen to have withdrawn its proposed credit and debit card rate.
