

AMENDED APPLICATION



NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

WATER RATE ADJUSTMENT

Pursuant to the Regulations of the Public Service Commission (Commission), the Madison County Utilities District (MCUD) gives Notice that it has filed a water rate increase with the Commission. It proposes the rates listed below, which are approximately a 10.46% average increase over the current rates to be effective April 1, 2009. The average customer bill will increase from \$30.42 per 690 cu. ft to \$34.16 per 690 cu. ft. Further information may be obtained from the Commission or the MCUD. The rates proposed in this Notice may be modified by the Commission. Such action by the Commission may result in the rates being higher or lower than those proposed by the MCUD.

Any corporation, association, body politic or person may by timely motion, with 30 days of this Notice, request intervention in this case. Intervention beyond the 30 day period may be granted for good cause shown. The Motion must be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Blvd., Box 615 Frankfort, KY 40602 and should state the ground for the request, including the interest and status of the party. Intervenors may obtain copies of the Application and any testimony filed by contacting the MCUD at the address below.
