COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST DATA REQUEST TO OHIO COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

Ohio County Water District ("Ohio District"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and 6 copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before December 2, 2008. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Ohio District shall make timely amendment to any prior responses if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Ohio

District fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a

written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely

respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When

the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested

format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to

this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for

total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. Provide a copy of the contract between the utility and the bank(s) or financial

institution(s) providing the credit card service.

2. State whether any of the agreements between Ohio District and its

credit/debit card service providers restrict or prohibit Ohio District's right to assess a fee to

persons using a credit card to pay for services from Ohio District.

3. If the response to Item 2 is yes, explain why Ohio District is proposing a

credit/debit card processing charge.
