

RE: Telephonic Informal Conference
Letcher County Water and Sewer District
Revise Non-Recurring Charge

On September 15, 2008, a teleconference was held between Commission Staff and the parties in this matter. Those participating in the call are listed on the attachment.

The purpose of the conference was to clarify the request for the meter connection/tap-on fee of \$650 as requested by Letcher District in its August 18, 2008 filing. Commission Staff requested that Letcher District file with the Commission its explanation of the requested adjustment. Letcher District stated that having to go back to the area after the project is completed is an added expense for the district. The cost of the barrel set is negligible in the initial construction of a project. Commission Staff voiced a concern about the charge being a penalty for not setting the "barrel" during construction and that there appeared to be no time limit for ending the project and the revised charge.

Staff requested Letcher District to file a further explanation of its request which will be placed in the case file. Letcher District agreed to do so.

The meeting was adjourned.
