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**WITNESS LIST OF COLUMBIA GAS OF KENTUCKY, INC.**

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On October 3, 2008, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") filed its Application in this case, requesting authority to extend its Gas Cost Incentive Mechanism ("GCIM") and its Off-System Sales and Capacity Release Revenue Sharing Mechanism ("OSS/CR RSM"). Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. ("IGS") moved to intervene on November 6, 2008, and on January 9, 2009, IGS filed Comments in this docket. By Order dated March 10, 2009, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered a finding that a hearing should be held on March 19, 2009 and further ordered all parties to file a list of witnesses they intend to offer at the hearing and a summary of the issues each witness will present, including the job title and duties of each witness.

Accordingly, Columbia hereby enters the name of Judy M. Cooper, Director of Regulatory Affairs, to testify as a witness in the hearing to commence on March 19, 2009. Ms. Cooper's duties consist of the management of Columbia's regulatory affairs, tariffs and filings with the Commission, including quarterly Gas Cost Adjustments and Columbia's local customer service functions Ms. Cooper will support all issues surrounding Columbia's Application to

extend its Gas Cost Incentive Mechanism and Off-System Sales and Capacity Release Revenue Sharing Mechanism, including the history of these programs.

While Columbia does not intend to present any other witness, Scott D. Phelps, Director of Gas Management Services, will be in attendance and can be made available to testify in the event Ms. Cooper is unable to answer a particular question regarding these aforementioned programs to the Commission's satisfaction. Mr. Phelps' duties consist of the negotiation of all gas purchases, the scheduling of the Columbia's gas supply on the interstate pipeline systems, the release of interstate transportation capacity, the sale of gas and services pursuant to Columbia's off system sales programs, and the related back office reconciliation, payment, and billing processes related to these transactions.

**WHEREFORE**, Columbia respectfully submits Judy M. Cooper as its primary and sole witness for the hearing scheduled to commence on March 19, 2009.

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
