O R D E R

On October 17, 2008, Rattlesnake Ridge Water District ("Rattlesnake Ridge") submitted an application for an adjustment of its water rates. In its application, Rattlesnake Ridge seeks a waiver from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(6)(r), because it does not routinely produce monthly managerial reports. Rattlesnake Ridge states that complying with this filing requirement would result in a prohibitive expense.

Based on the application and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that good cause has been shown to permit Rattlesnake Ridge to deviate from the requirement to provide monthly managerial reports and that a waiver should be granted pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
