In RE: Purchased Water Adjustment for Southern Madison Water District

Dear Ms. Stumbo:

I am the attorney for Southern Madison Water District. The Berea Municipal Utilities, from whom we purchase our water, has recently raised the wholesale water rate they charge Southern Madison Water District. Our Board passed a resolution adopting new rates to be effective September 8, 2008.

I enclose the following:

1. A copy of the Notice of Increase received by the District from Berea Municipal Utilities as well as a copy of the letter to you informing of the proposed wholesale rate change;
2. A Purchased Water Adjustment Application in which we calculated the purchased water adjustment factor;
3. Proof of publication of the Public Notice which was published in the Richmond Register, the only daily newspaper of general circulation in our service area. This was published on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2008, and our first bills at the increased rates will be rendered on October 29, 2008.
