Please be advised that if the requested rate increase of 50.8% by Utilities Inc. is allowed it will affect me in the following ways:

First of all, I think I can speak for all the citizens of Clinton by saying that since the Utilities Inc. took over our water bills have been ridiculous to say the least. There were months people didn't get a bill at all and then they would get a 3 or 400 dollar bill. At the rate our economy is going we will never be able to afford bills like this. I am eight and a half months pregnant and on bedrest and my husband was recently laid off from work. As if my situation is not bad enough, what about the elderly people that are living on fixed incomes?! Also, I have an aunt that has been without water for almost a month because her bill is \$800.00. None of the surrounding counties have water bills as high as ours and to raise it again will just result in a lot of unpaid bills and unhappy people. If this matter is not resolved, we are seriously considering putting in a well, like many other people I know.

I request that you hold a public meeting in the city of Clinton so that the citizens can attend and voice their opposition to you directly.
