Accident Investigation – Louisville Gas & Electric Co.

An informal conference was held on March 4, 2009, pursuant to the request of Louisville Gas & Electric Company (“LG&E”). The names of those present at the informal conference appear on the attached sign-in sheet.

The informal conference was held in regard to the show cause Order issued by the Commission on February 11, 2009 to LG&E for an alleged violation of KRS 278.042. The alleged violation resulted from an investigation of an accident in which Anthony Acton, a contract employee working for LG&E, was injured while installing new service at an LG&E work site. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss settlement of the case.

LG&E and Commission Staff discussed the issues surrounding the injury to the contract worker. Commission Staff suggested the possibility of LG&E implementing additional documentation requirements for daily job briefings by LG&E employees and LG&E’s contractors. LG&E agreed to evaluate the suggestions further and respond to Commission Staff within a week.¹

Commission Staff stated that, as the settlement discussions were proceeding effectively, it was not necessary to reschedule the show cause hearing at the present time.

There being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned.
