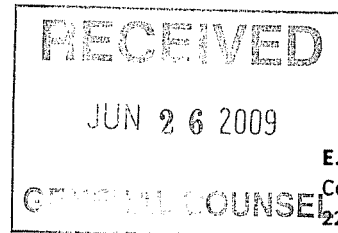



**NOTICE OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
IN RESPONSE TO THE COMMISSION'S ORDER OF MAY 27, 2009**

On May 27, 2009, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an Order adopting and approving the Joint Stipulation of Facts and Settlement Agreement ("Joint Stipulation") in its entirety as a complete resolution of all issues in the above-captioned proceeding. In that Order, the Commission required Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") to file, within 30 days of the date of this Order, a notice setting forth the name and job title of the LG&E employee who will be responsible for ensuring that:

(a) All LG&E crews and resident contractor crews maintain written documentation of their daily job briefings; and

(b) LG&E issues a request to all of their mutual assistance crews and off-system contractor crews to maintain written documentation of their daily job briefings.

In the Joint Stipulation, LG&E agreed to require all of its employees and resident contractors who perform work on LG&E's electric distribution system to document in

writing that they have had a daily job briefing and to request that all mutual assistance or off-system contractors who perform work on LG&E's electric distribution system document in writing their daily job briefings. Any person working alone is not required by OSHA to conduct a daily job briefing and therefore documentation in such case is not required.¹


Line managers who ultimately report up to David Guy, Director, System Restoration and Dispatch Operations, will check for documentation during their routine audits of the work crews. In addition, review and confirmation of documentation of daily job briefings will also occur during the safety audits that are randomly conducted. When mutual assistance crews and off-system contractor crews are needed, LG&E will request that those crews document in writing their daily job briefings at the time of their Passport training.

Employees and resident contractors who perform work on LG&E's electric distribution system will maintain documentation of daily job briefings for a period of 30 days. Such documentation will be kept in the same fashion as work orders and other types of documents.

¹ See 29 CFR 1910.269(c)(3) "Working alone." An employee working alone need not conduct a job briefing. However, the employer shall ensure that the tasks to be performed are planned as if a briefing were required.


