O R D E R


On January 28, 2009, Powertel/Memphis, Inc., a Delaware corporation, d/b/a T-Mobile Kentucky ("T-Mobile") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to construct a wireless communications tower in Muhlenberg County, Kentucky. On May 28, 2009, the application was placed in abeyance by Commission Order, pending a decision in *L. Glenn Shadoan, et al. v. Kentucky Public Service Commission, et al.*, Kentucky Supreme Court Case No. 2009-SC-000053-DR. On August 7, 2009, the Commission received a letter from T-Mobile requesting to withdraw the application. T-Mobile was able to arrange for co-location on an existing structure.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter is dismissed and removed from the Commission's docket.
