
MEMORANDUM OF THE KENTUCKY MUNICIPAL UTILITY ASSOCIATION

The Kentucky Municipal Utility Association (“KMUA”), by counsel, and in response to the Attorney General’s Motion for Abeyance states as follows:

The focal issue in this case is whether the KRA fee should remain a separate line item on customers’ bills. Based on the filings in this case so far, that issue does not appear to be one that involves an extreme urgency of time. Accordingly, if the Commission deems it prudent to await Supreme Court decisions that may shed light on jurisdictional issues then an abeyance or slight delay in this matter would not be objectionable to KMUA


