Big Sandy Water District has experienced a rate increase from one of our suppliers, the City of Kenova, WV, and we are asking approval to increase rates through the Purchase Water Adjustment (807 KAR 5:068) to our customers. As you can see from Exhibit A, we changed from \$1.61 per thousand to \$1.79 per thousand, also we now pay .10 surcharge per thousand and a .02 surcharge per thousand-that is supposed to be a .04 surcharge per thousand (see copy of last bill) until arrearage has been satisfied on each surcharge. At that time, we will ask for a rate decrease. A notice to our customers will be published in the Daily Independent. Our total expenses and revenue have been furnished to the PSC in our annual report. Enclosed are the original and ten copies of the applications, exhibits, and new tariff sheets. 

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

(C) DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent will be added to the net current amount unpaid. The delayed payment penalty is not interest and is only to be collected once for each bill where it is appropriate.

(N) RESALE RATE

All water for resale will be bill in accordance with the approved rate of \$1.79 per 1,000 gallons used per month.

(C) RECONNECTION FEE

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

(C) TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$500.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the service.

RATE SCHEDULE I (Continued)

METER TESTING FEE

If any customer shall request in writing a test of the accuracy of his or her water meter, and the meter is not due for periodic testing in accordance with the rules of the Public Service Commission, Kenova shall notify the customer of the conditions under which the test will be made. If the customer shall then request the City to proceed with the test and remit the amount of \$20, Kenova shall make the test promptly. A report giving the results of the test shall be made to the customer and a complete record of the test shall be remitted to the Public Service Commission. If, when tested, the meter is found to be more than two percent (2%) in error, the amount advanced shall be promptly refunded to the customer. If the meter is not found to be more than two percent (2%) in error, the Utility shall retain the amount advanced by the customer for the test.

(N) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$0.49 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

(N) RETURNED CHECK FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the utility or a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

(N) SECURITY DEPOSIT

A deposit of \$50.00 or 2/12ths of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific customer class, whichever is greater.

(N) SURCHARGE 1

\$0.24 per 1,000 gallons per month, applicable to residential, commercial, and industrial customers, from the effective date of the tariff, will be charged in order to eliminate the arrearage to the Municipal Bond Commission. The respective surcharge will cease upon the arrearage being satisfied.

\$0.10 per 1,000 gallons per month, applicable to all resale customers, from the effective date of the tariff will be charged in order to eliminate the arrearage to the Municipal Bond Commission. The respective surcharge will cease upon the arrearage being satisfied.

WATER USER AGREEMENT – SPECIAL CONTRACT

This Agreement entered into between Cannonsburg Water District whose address is 1606 Cannonsburg Rd, Ashland Kentucky 41102, party of the FIRST PART, and the Big Sandy Water District, 18200 State Route 3, Catlettsburg, Kentucky, Boyd County, party of the SECOND PART.

WHEREAS, the party of the FIRST PART desires to purchase water from the party of the SECOND PART, the party of the FIRST PART enters into this Water User Agreement as required by the BYLAWS of the Party of the SECOND PART and as defined in 807 KAR 5:011, Tariffs, Section 13, Special Contracts.

NOW THEROF, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

The party of the SECOND PART shall furnish, subject to the limitations set out in its BYLAWS and Rules and Regulations now in force or as here after amended, such quantity of water as the party of the FIRST PART may desire for domestic use in connection with property to be served by this Agreement. The property to be serviced is known as Dog Fork and Laurel Ridge.

The party of the FIRST PART shall install and maintain at its own expense a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the place of use. The location of the water meters on the property will be determined by mutual agreement of the parties, which shall be the nearest point to the water main of purchaser's property. The party of the SECOND PART shall continue to furnish and maintain a cutoff valve and a 3" water meter. Any future location of connections and meters to this property shall be determined by mutual agreement. The party of the FIRST PART agrees to pay a connection fee equal to the actual cost.

The MINIMUM BILL for service to the party of the FIRST PART under this Agreement shall be \$ 1.49, plus \$.42 cents (Big Sandy Water District's present cost from Kenova Water) per thousand gallons of water per month on the total of all meters.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, BYLAWS, Rules and Regulations of the party of the SECOND PART now in force or as hereafter duly a legally supplemented, amended, or changed. The party of the FIRST PART agrees to pay for water at such time and place as shall be determined by the party of the SECOND PART, and agrees to the imposition of such penalties for noncompliance as are now set out in the party of the SECOND PART'S BYLAWS and Rules and Regulations, or which have been or hereafter shall be adopted and imposed by the party of the SECOND PART.

The party of the FIRST PART shall agree to any further rate changes in the cost of purchased water incurred by Big Sandy Water District from their supplier that shall be passed through to Cannonsburg Water District in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068.

In the event that the Big Sandy Water District must allocate and/or limit water use to the Cannonsburg Water District for if more than two (2) days, then the will have the option of reconnecting their own water system and not be obligated to a minimum bill for the next 30 day billing period, or until water is available from the Big Sandy Water District on a continuous basis as previously provided before change in systems.

The contract shall remain in effect for 20 years and is renewable at 10-year intervals.

The failure of the party of the FIRST PART to pay water charges duly imposed shall result in the automatic imposition of the penalties in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11 (3) and the Big Sandy Water District's tariff rates as approved by the Public Service Commission.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to grant to the party of the SECOND PART, its successors an assigns, a perpetual easement in, over, under, and upon land owned by the party of the FIRST PART with the right to erect, construct, install, and lay, and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace, and remove water pipelines and appurtenant facilities together with the right to utilize adjoining lands belonging to the party of the SECOND PART for the purpose of ingress and egress from the said lands.

This contract replaces the most previous contract and is the same except the change in the amount per thousand charges for water, which reflects the increase cost from our supplier.




