RATES AND CHARGES

TARIFF AS TO INCREASE IN WHOLESALE WATER RATE

KRS 278.015(2) AND 807 KAR 5:068 provides essentially the manner in which a Water District may implement a Purchase Water Adjustment designed to recover the actual cost of water purchased by a Water District from a wholesale supplier.

The Allen County Water District purchases substantially all of its water from the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission of Glasgow, Kentucky. By its Ordinance No. 2633, the City of Glasgow, Kentucky, established new rates for the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission to charge increased new wholesale rates to be charged to its customers, including the Allen County Water District, effective July 1, 2008 (\$1.40 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.75 per 1,000 gallons) AND effective July 1, 2009 (\$1.75 per 1000 gallons to \$1.95 per 1,000 gallons). A copy of said Ordinance is attached hereto as a part hereof.

The Allen County Water District was notified of this increase by a letter from the Glasgow Water Company, dated May 16, 2008. A copy of said letter is filed herewith as a part hereof.

By Letter to the Allen County Water District from its Engineer, Kenvirons, Inc., dated July 25, 2008, the Water District was informed as follows:

"The indication is that the district could absorb the increased purchased water cost relative to the \$1.75 per thousand gallons rated along with the adjustments to the 2007 expenses. Next year the rate will increase to \$1.95. Based on the same parameters, the purchased water cost will increase an additional \$69,092, which would cause a negative net income of approximately \$41,000. The above calculations do not consider any customer growth, which would generate a small amount of additional revenues. The conclusion is that the district would absorb the initial \$1.75 per thousand rate, but not the \$1.95 that is proposed to be effective next year. The \$1.75 rate results in an increase in customer rate of \$0.41 per thousand gallons. The \$1.95 rate result in an additional \$0.23 per thousand gallons for a total of \$0.64 per thousand gallons."

RATES AND CHARGES

The current wholesale base rate of the City of Glasgow is \$1.40 per thousand gallons. The changed rate of the City of Glasgow is \$1.75 per thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2008, as shown on the City of Glasgow's Ordinance No. 2633.

The twelve month period upon which the purchased water adjustment is April, 2008 through March, 2009.

Gallons purchased by Allen County Water District from City of Glasgow during the 12 month period is 347,791,400; from the City of Scottsville is 8,943,800; a total of 356,735,200 gallons.

Total gallons sold by Allen County Water District for the 12 month period is 295,078,700.

The annual increased water cost is \$121,726.99 [347,791,400 gallons x \$0.35 per 1000 gallons = \$121,726.99]. (\$1.75 less \$1.40 = \$0.35)

The purchased water adjustment factor is, therefore, \$0.41 per 1000 gallons (\$121,726.99 divided by 295,078.700 gallons = \$0.41 per 1000 gallons)




Dear Wholesale Customer:

Due to increased operating expenses the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission has determined that our wholesale water rate must be increased. The current wholesale rate of \$1.40 per one thousand gallons has been in effect for over five years. The new rate will be an increase of 55 cents per one thousand gallons. However, the new rate will be phased over a two year period as follows: On July 1, 2008, the wholesale rate to be charged for water purchased on and after that date shall be \$1.75 per one thousand gallons. On July 1, 2009, the wholesale rate to be charged for water purchased on and after that date shall be \$1.95 per one thousand gallons.


The rate change will be effective July 1, 2008, however it will not appear on your bill until August, because it will apply only to water used after July 1, 2008.

A detailed rate analysis was performed to determine the necessary rate increase. The analysis addresses both wholesale and retail rates independently and examines expenses attributed to the wholesale rate. Approximately 34% of all water sold by the Glasgow Water Company provides service to our wholesale customers. The rate analysis indicates that the current rate is among the lowest in the state of Kentucky while the proposed rate is below the \$1.97 average of wholesale rates available on the Public Service Commission's website.

Enclosed you will find a Public Service Commission tariff sheet, a copy of the wholesale water rate ordinance, and a copy of the cost study analysis used to determine the new wholesale rate.

The Glasgow Water Company appreciates the great working relationship with your utility and will always work diligently with you in the supply of water to your customers. If you have any questions regarding the matter please contact me anytime.

(Revises Board's Resolutions of 02/03/,2009 and 04/07/2009)**

KRS 278.015(2) AND 807 KAR 5:068 provides essentially the manner in which a Water District may implement a Purchase Water Adjustment designed to recover the actual cost of water purchased by a Water District from a wholesale supplier.

The Allen County Water District purchases substantially all of its water from the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission of Glasgow, Kentucky. By its Ordinance No. 2633, the City of Glasgow, Kentucky, established new rates for the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission to charge increased new wholesale rates to be charged to its customers, including the Allen County Water District, effective July 1, 2008 (\$1.40 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.75 per 1,000 gallons) AND effective July 1, 2009 (\$1.75 per 1000 gallons to \$1.95 per 1,000 gallons). A copy of said Ordinance is attached hereto as a part hereof.

By Letter dated July 25, 2008, to the Allen County Water District from its engineer, KENVIRONS, INC., the Water District was informed

"The indication is that the district could absorb the increased purchased water cost relative to the \$1.75 per thousand gallons rated along with the adjustments to the 2007 expenses. Next year the rate will increase to \$1.95. Based on the same parameters, the purchased water cost will increase an additional \$69,092, which would cause a negative net income of approximately \$41,000. The above calculations do not consider any customer growth, which would generate a small amount of additional revenues. The conclusion is that the district would absorb the initial \$1.75 per thousand rate, but not the \$1.95 that is proposed to be effective next year. The \$1.75 rate results in an increase in customer rate of \$0.41 per thousand gallons. The \$1.95 rate result in an additional \$0.23 per thousand gallons for a total of \$0.64 per thousand gallons."

On February 3, 2009, the Board of Commissioners of the Allen County Water District passed a Resolution to absorb the increase in the Purchase Water Cost from Glasgow Water Company, effective July 1, 2008, from \$1.40 per thousand gallons to \$1.75 per thousand gallons. This increase will not be passed on the customers of the Allen County Water District.

The last increase in Allen County Water District's rates to its customers was May 25, 1993, when the rates were increased from \$13.45 minimum for the first two thousand gallons to \$16.17 minimum for the first two thousand gallons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the Allen County Water District, this 19th day of May, 2009, as follows:

1. That for the purpose of complying with the Order of the Public Service Commission, dated May 5, 2009, the Board of Commissioners adopts the following Purchased Water Adjustment based on the Glasgow Water Company's Wholesale Increase from \$1.40 per one thousand gallons to \$1.75 per one thousand gallons, effective June 30, 2009.

In support of this increase from \$1.40 per one thousand gallons to \$1.75 per one thousand gallons, the Board of Commissioners of the Allen County Water District attaches the required calculations prepared by the Allen County Water District's Engineer, Kenvirons.

2. That for the further purpose of complying with the Order of the Public Service Commission, dated May 5, 2009, the Board of Commissioners adopts the following Purchased Water Adjustment based on the Glasgow Water Company's Wholesale Increase from \$1.75 per one thousand gallons to \$1.95 per one thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2009.

In support of this increase from \$1.75 per one thousand gallons to \$1.95 per one thousand gallons, the Board of Commissioners of the Allen County Water District attaches the required calculations prepared by the Allen County Water District's Engineer, Kenvirons.

The adjusted rates effective July 1, 2009 are as follows:

4. The Chairman of the Board, Mr. John H. Jones, is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to sign the Purchase Water Adjustment application for and on behalf of the Allen County Water District.

5. This resolution is subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission. Once the Commission approves, the Allen County Water District will notify all customers of the new rates prior to the first billing of the new rates

The Resolution was put to a vote. There 5 ayes and 0 nays, and the Chairman declared the Resolution adopted.

However, the new rate will be phased over a two year period as follows: On July 1, 2008, the wholesale rate to be charged for water purchased on and after that date shall be \$1.75 per one thousand gallons. On July 1, 2009, the wholesale rate to be charged for water purchased on and after that date shall be \$1.95 per one thousand gallons.


The rate change will be effective July 1, 2008, however it will not appear on your bill until August, because it will apply only to water used after July 1, 2008.

A detailed rate analysis was performed to determine the necessary rate increase. The analysis addresses both wholesale and retail rates independently and examines expenses attributed to the wholesale rate. Approximately 34% of all water sold by the Glasgow Water Company provides service to our wholesale customers. The rate analysis indicates that the current rate is among the lowest in the state of Kentucky while the proposed rate is below the \$1.97 average of wholesale rates available on the Public Service Commission's website.

Enclosed you will find a Public Service Commission tariff sheet, a copy of the wholesale water rate ordinance, and a copy of the cost study analysis used to determine the new wholesale rate.
