RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE
FARMDALE WATER DISTRICT

807 KAR 5:066 Water

- (1) Each customer shall be metered individually - 1 meter per residence or business.
- (2) Each customer who has two or more residences on one meter will have the option of installing a meter or meters or paying a minimum monthly charge per residence or business.
- (3.) In the event customer do not respond by accepting one of the options, Farmdale Water will install the meter.
- (4) For example, a customer has two residences, a single family home and a mobile home and one meter. This customer is required to pay 2 minimum billing amounts (\$8.98 for a 5/8" x 3/4" meter) or \$17.96 for 4,000 gallons. Usage in excess of the 4,000 gallons will follow the pertinent tariff billing rates.
