


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MOTION TO AMEND ORDER

This Motion of the Ohio County Water District ("Applicant"), by Counsel, respectfully shows:

1. That on July 21, 2009, the Commission issued its Order in **Case No. 2009-00244** approving a proposed rate change pursuant to KRS 278.023.
2. That the rates contained in the U. S. Department of Agriculture, acting through Rural Development ("RD") Letter of Conditions, dated June 2, 2007, have been revised to reflect a change in the wholesale rate category from specific users (City of Beaver Dam and City of Fordsville) to all users, and accordingly, RD has issued Amendment No. 2, dated August 4, 2009, which Amendment clarifies that the Applicant's wholesale rate applies to all wholesale users. Applicant files a copy of Amendment No. 2 with this Motion.
4. That Applicant files this Motion to request that the Commission amend it's Order to reflect that the Applicant's wholesale rate applies to all wholesale users.
5. That Applicant will file an amended rate tariff sheet to reflect the change in wholesale rate category upon the issuance by the Commission of it's amended Order.

WHEREFORE, Applicant, the Ohio County Water District, by counsel, asks that the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky amend it's Order as to the wholesale rate category in accordance with Amendment No. 2 to the RD Letter of Conditions.

Re: Letter of Conditions Dated June 26, 2007

Dear Chairman Storm:

This letter shall serve as Amendment No. 2 to the Letter of Conditions dated June 26, 2007. The purpose of this amendment is to make editorial revisions to the proposed wholesale rate structure.

Paragraph numbered "29" is revised to read as follows:

" 29. Rates and Charges:

Rates and charges for facilities and services rendered by the District must be at least adequate to meet cost of maintaining, repairing and operating the water system and meeting required principal and interest payments and the required deposits to debt service and/or depreciation reserve.


Water rates will be at least:

First	2,000	gallons @ \$	21.13. - Minimum Bill.
Next	18,000	gallons @ \$	8.78. - per 1,000 gallons.
Next	30,000	gallons @ \$	7.59. - per 1,000 gallons.
Next	50,000	gallons @ \$	6.39. - per 1,000 gallons.
Next	100,000	gallons @ \$	5.20. - per 1,000 gallons.
All Over	200,000	gallons @ \$	5.20. - per 1,000 gallons.

Wholesale rate to all users will be \$2.68 per 1,000 gallons.

All other provisions of the referenced Letter of Conditions remain in full force and unchanged.
