Key Points

- Execution of the Grand Ridge wind PPA is scheduled for early next week. A filing with the PSC will follow shortly thereafter.
- Brine testing rig was completed on the Western Kentucky deep well. Approximately 300 tons of CO₂ is schedule to be injected next week.
- Initial biomass co-firing studies by Burns and McDonnell indicate that the estimated capital cost for fuel yard modification may be substantially higher than anticipated. The expected all in cost of power from biomass co-firing, however, remains likely to be our lowest cost source of renewable power.
