O R D E R

On March 24, 2010, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") filed a notice stating that they had terminated the two 20-year contracts for the purchase of wind power that had been filed in this case for approval as evidences of indebtedness under KRS 278.300. Copies of letters that were sent to the sellers to terminate the wind power contracts were attached to the notice. LG&E and KU also state that their application in this case is being withdrawn as moot.

Based on the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to allow LG&E and KU to withdraw their pending application for approval of two wind power contracts.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
