ATTENTION PROPERTY OWNERS INSPECTION PERIOD FOR THE PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT ROLL

The Anderson County real property tax roll will be opened for inspection from May 3 through May 17, 2010. Under the supervision of the property valuation administrator or one of the deputies, any person may inspect the tax roll.

This is the January 1, 2010 assessment on which state, county, library, health, fire, extension, and school taxes for 2010 will be due after September 15, 2010. The PVA office does not set tax rates. Kentucky law requires that property be assessed equally and uniformly, that each parcel of property be inspected for re-assessment at least once every four years, and that the assessment reflect the price the property would bring in a voluntary sale between a willing buyer and willing seller, given a reasonable time on the market. Assessment notices will be sent to property owners by May 1st ONLY if the assessed value has changed.

The tax roll is in the office of the property valuation administrator at 101 Ollie Bowen Court (beside the courthouse) and may be inspected between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday and 8:30 a.m.-12:00 noon on Saturdays.

Any taxpayer desiring to appeal an assessment on real property made by the PVA must first request a conference with a designated deputy. The conference may be held prior to or during the inspection period.

Any taxpayer still aggrieved by an assessment on real property after the conference with the PVA or designated deputy may appeal to the county board of assessment appeals.

The taxpayer can appeal his assessment by filing in person or sending a letter or other written petition stating the reasons for appeal, identifying the property and stating the taxpayer's opinion of the fair cash value of the property.

The appeal must be filed with the county clerk's office no later than May 18th.

A taxpayer failing to appeal to the county board of assessment appeals, or failing to appear before the board, either in person or by designated representative, will not be eligible to appeal directly to the Kentucky Board of Tax Appeals.
