Filing Deficiencies

The Commission staff has reviewed your application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

1. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001:

807 KAR 5:001: Section 10(1)(b)(8) Proposed tariff changes shown either by providing present and proposed tariffs in comparative form or indicating additions by italicized inserts or underscoring and striking over deletions in a copy of the current tariff.

807 KAR 5:001: Section 10(3)(b) The present and proposed rates for each customer class to which the proposed rates would apply.

807 KAR 5:001: Section 10(6)(a) A complete description and quantified explanation for all proposed adjustments with proper support for any proposed changes in price or activity levels, and any other factors which may affect the adjustment.

807 KAR 5:001: Section 10(6)(b) & (c) If the utility has gross annual revenues greater than \$1,000,000, the prepared testimony of each witness the utility proposes to use to support its application. If the utility has gross annual revenues less than \$1,000,000, the prepared testimony of each witness the utility proposes to use to support its application or a statement that the utility does not plan to submit any prepared testimony.

807 KAR 5:001: Section 10(7)(d) The operating budget for each month of the period encompassing the pro forma adjustments

When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may refile your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information.
