Comes now the intervenor, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, and in regard to Kentucky Power Company's Motion for Confidential Treatment, hereby files the following Motion for Hearing.


In support of his Motion, the Attorney General states that on or about March 5, 2010, his office filed a Response with regard to Kentucky Power Company's ["KP"] "Motion for Confidential Treatment" (pertaining to its responses to AG 1-47 through AG 1-5) and that on or about March 12, 2010, the Company filed its Reply in support of its motion for confidential treatment of the subject responses. Those data requests, KP's responses thereto and the various motions, responses and replies of the parties are now filed of record.

As part of its Reply, the Company offered testimony, by way of affidavit, of Ms. Renee V. Hawkins, the Assistant Treasurer and Managing Director, Corporate Finance for American Electric Power Service Corporation. In her affidavit, Ms. Hawkins makes statements regarding the alleged harm claimed by the Company that would result from the disclosure of the subject information. The Attorney General seeks an evidentiary

hearing for the purpose of cross examination of Ms. Hawkins with regard to her statements in her affidavit and states that as the Commission must make a determination with respect to the issue of confidentiality, such a hearing is required to satisfy due process concerns. Utility Regulatory Commission v. Kentucky Water Service Company, Inc., Ky.App., 642 S.W.2d 591, 593 (1982).

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General respectfully requests that the Commission schedule an evidentiary hearing in the matter and order the affiant to appear before it for the purposes of cross examining her testimony.

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
