for a Rate Increase

Notice is given of a Request for an  
Intervention in Kentucky Utilities  
proposed Rate Increase for these reasons:

1. Any Kentucky Resident, such as myself,  
has a substantial interest in not permitting  
our utility bills to be raised unnecessarily.  
KU cannot justify any increase. Their  
only goal is to gouge the public so they  
can make more money for themselves.  
Service will not improve. The public will  
not benefit. And just like the Water Company's  
annual thieving spree, once you start overfeeding  
pigs at the trough, the more often they'll be  
back wanting more.
2. Kentucky Utilities has nothing but contempt  
for the Public. They have the greed of a  
Corporation, and report to the credit bureaus  
like they were a Bank or lending institution.

Every time there's an ice storm, or a power outage, they take their phones off the hook so they don't have to be bothered with us. Even their own employees think that is disgraceful. They cut off power in the wintertime to families with children, forcing them into life or death situations, yet they'll spend tens of thousands of dollars on attorneys fees to push through a rate hike.
