I am trying to make things on my own, but with this expected \$12.00 (\$240.00/year) rate increase per month is absolutely not necessary at this time. I work at the University of Kentucky, I have not and will not receive a pay increase for at least another 2 years, that would be 4 years without raises. I cannot express how deeply irritated I am at how such a large business would be able to raise rates at a time like this when fruit, gas, foods are becoming higher and higher.
