
I know as I write this letter that it will probably go into a trash bin, and will make no difference at all, but I felt I should at least make the effort.

LG&E wants an annual increase of 12.19% for electricity and 8.75% for gas, yet at the end of the year when they disclose their profits, they are usually in the billions!

My husband has not had a raise for five years and 2009, he made about ½ of what he made in 2008. I work for the educational system and I received a 1% raise and 1% will be my raise for next year. We turn the furnace down at night and when we leave for work trying to hold our bill down. How are we going to continue to pay for such high increases?

People all over Kentucky and the country are losing their jobs and taking cuts in wages. With the economy the way it is, how can LG&E possibly justify this percentage of increase?
