
Dear Mr. DeRouen:

By order dated July 19, 2010, the Commission reset the hearing in this matter for Wednesday, September 15, 2010. Based upon the informal conference held in this matter on July 7, 2010, and the number of witnesses in the case, Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") believes it is likely that the hearing will require more than one day. Big Rivers respectfully requests that the hearing be commenced on Tuesday, September 14, 2010, to allow two days for the hearing. Big Rivers is authorized to state that starting the hearing on September 14 is acceptable to Midwest ISO and KIUC.
