IN THE ABOVE APPLICATION**


New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("Applicant"), by counsel, respectfully requests the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") to grant a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") in the within administrative proceeding forthwith based on the following facts and circumstances:

1. Applicant has met all filing requirements applicable to this proceeding as prescribed by the Kentucky Revised Statutes and the Kentucky Administrative Regulations.
2. Landowners required to be notified have been so notified by certified mail. Signs depicted in the Application have been posted at and near the site since the filing date of the Application and a legal notice has been published in the Clinton County News.
3. To date and subsequent to such notification of potentially interested parties; no request for intervention has been filed with the PSC in this case.

4. The Wireless Communication Facility ("WCF") subject to the Application for a CPCN filed in this case is a vital element of the Applicant's wireless provisions of the Federal Communications Commission license. The WCF is a replacement site for one that utilizes a municipal water tank. Said water tank has been decommissioned and is scheduled for demolition. It is imperative that Applicant constructs the WCF as expeditiously as possible to avoid a lapse in the existing coverage. Expedited approval of the CPCN shall provide the Applicant with much need time to construct WCF and maintain the availability of its service to this area.

Wherefore, the Applicant, by Counsel, urges the PSC to grant a CPCN forthwith.
