

US 60 Water District is requesting to adjust the company's rates to cover the recent decrease imposed by one of our suppliers. The Frankfort Plant Board has decreased the rate they charged us by \$0.118/1000 gallons per Commission Order in Case No. 2008-00250 dated April 6, 2009. As required by 807 KAR 5:001 and 807 KAR 5:068, we have attached 10 copies of the application including the PWA form and our revised tariff sheets. It is our understanding that 807 KAR 5:068, Section 5, only applies to an increase in rates, and therefore, it is not necessary for us to provide our customers notice of the decrease.

We are also requesting to refund to our customers the \$4597.18 refunded to us by the Frankfort Plant Board on the April 2010 billings at the rate of \$0.50/1000 gallons. In order to calculate the refund, we have estimated our March 2010 sales to be 9,036,800, which was the amount sold in March 2009. We believe that we will have similar sales during March 2010 as we did in March 2009.
