Pursuant to the Commission's Informal Conference Memorandum dated May 10, 2010, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Kentucky would like to suggest the following clarification to the Memorandum:

In the second bullet point regarding whether Merger Commitment 7.4 (as it pertains to AT&T Kentucky) had been raised before or was pending before any other state commission, the Parties' negative responses pertained to Merger Commitment 7.4 as it relates to the issues raised in this arbitration. While Merger Commitment 7.4 has been raised before this Commission and others in other contexts, it has not been addressed in the context at issue in this case.

Accordingly, AT&T Kentucky suggests that the second sentence of the second bullet point be modified to read, "The parties stated that the issue concerning Merger Commitment 7.4 presented in this proceeding has not been addressed by any other state commission, nor is it pending before any other state commission."
