Filing Deficiencies

The Commission staff has reviewed Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corp.'s application in the above case. The filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below:

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

- (1) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10 (1)(b)(3) and (5) - If the utility is incorporated, a certified copy of the utility's articles of incorporation and all amendments thereto or out of state documents of similar import. If the utility's articles of incorporation and amendments have already been filed with the Commission in a prior proceeding, the application may state this fact making reference to the style and case number of the prior proceeding and a certificate of good standing or certificate of authorization dated within sixty (60) days of the date the application is filed.
- (2) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(7) - The proposed tariff in form complying with 807 KAR 5:011 with an effective date not less than thirty (30) days from the date the application is filed. (Customer Deposit Tariff Omitted)
- (3) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(8) - Proposed tariff changes shown either by providing present and proposed tariffs in comparative form or indicating additions by italicized inserts or underscoring and striking over deletions in a copy of the current tariff. (Customer Deposit Tariff Omitted)
- (4) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(e) - Number of customers to be added to the test period – end level of customers and the related revenue requirements impact for all pro forma adjustments with complete details and supporting work papers.

- (5) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(a) - Amount of change requested in dollar amounts and percentage for each customer classification to which change will apply.
- (6) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(b) - Present and proposed rates for each customer class to which change would apply.
- (7) 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(4) – If copy of public notice included, did it meet requirements?

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids the proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies you may refile your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 10 copies of this information within 15 days of date of this letter.
