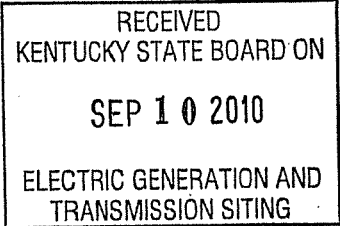

HENDERSON WATER UTILITY'S
MOTION TO COMPEL RESPONSE FROM VECTREN
AND FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO ANSWER FIRST INFORMATION REQUEST


Comes Henderson Water Utility (hereinafter referred to as "HWU"), by counsel, and moves the Siting Board for an Order Compelling the Applicant to provide data and for an extension of time within which to respond to the data requests filed by the Staff in this matter and those data requests filed by the Applicant.

In support of its Motion, HWU states that it only obtained Volume 2 of the application and certain other information from the Applicant on Friday, September 3, 2010 at the offices of its counsel in Lexington, Kentucky. That information was immediately copied and forwarded by Federal Express to the Intervenor but was not received until September 7, 2010. Portions of that document purport to contain Structural Detail Sheets which are integral to HWU's responses to the data requested by both the staff and the Applicant. Without those Structural Detail Sheets it is impossible for the HWU to file complete responses to the Data Requests of both the Applicant and the Staff.

Without those structural detail sheets, HWU would be assuming size, type, structural configuration and other technical data which would be contained in the structural detail sheets, and therefore its responses to the data requests of the Staff and Applicant would be mere speculation.

WHEREFORE, the Intervenor Henderson Water Utility moves the Siting Board for an Order requiring the Applicant to immediately provide to it the Structural Detail Sheets which are identified in the index of drawings contained Volume 2 of the Application, and that it be given a reasonable time of not less than 3 working days, from the date of receipt of those drawings, to respond to the Data Requests of both the Applicant and the Staff in this proceeding.


