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INTERVENOR HENDERSON WATER UTILITY'S MOTION TO RESCHEDULE FORMAL EVIDENTIARY HEARING; AND TO EXTEND DEADLINES FOR THE FILING OF WITNESS LISTS, SUMMARIES OF WITNESS TESTIMONY AND DIRECT TESTIMONY

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Comes the Intervenor, Henderson Water Utility ("HWU"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (the "Board"), to reschedule the formal evidentiary hearing in this matter, and to extend the deadlines for filing witness lists, summaries of witness testimony and direct testimony. As grounds for its Motion, HWU states as follows:

By Order entered August 31, 2010, the Board issued a Revised Procedural Schedule ("Schedule") pertaining to the Application for a Certificate to Construct a Nonregulated Electric Transmission Line ("Application") filed by Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Co., d/b/a Vectren Energy Delivery of Indiana, Inc. ("Vectren"). Pursuant to the Schedule, a formal evidentiary hearing is scheduled in regard to the Application for October 13, 2010. The parties are required to file witness lists together with brief summaries of testimony by no later than September 20, 2010. The parties are required to file direct testimony by September 28, 2010.

To adequately present its case before the Board, it is necessary that HWU retain experts to review, analyze and testify on its behalf in regard to the Application. HWU, however, is currently unable to retain appropriate experts and completely identify and prepare potential areas of witness testimony as Vectren has failed and refused to completely answer data requests served by HWU. Although HWU has received limited responses from Vectren, it has not received full and complete responses to its data requests regarding, among others, the specific location of transmission facilities and the specifics regarding its planned construction design. Although HWU has filed a Motion to Compel, Vectren has not provided the requested data. Without such data, it is impossible for HWU to identify those witnesses who will testify on its behalf at the formal evidentiary hearing, to provide brief summaries of their testimony, or to file direct testimony.

As a result, HWU moves that the formal evidentiary hearing be extended for a reasonable period of time after Vectren fully and completely responds to HWU's data requests; and that the deadlines to file witness lists, brief summaries of testimony and direct testimony be similarly reasonably extended until after such time that Vectren's responses are received. HWU emphasizes that it has diligently worked to meet the deadlines set forth in the Schedule but the failure of Vectren to supply necessary data and information renders compliance with the deadlines impossible. Further, HWU does not object to similar reasonable extensions of time being granted to the remaining Intervenors and the Applicant, Vectren, herein.

WHEREFORE, the Intervenor, Henderson Water Utility, respectfully requests that its Motion herein be granted.
