Dear Mr. Derouen:

On June 1, 2012 Armstrong Telecommunications, Inc. ("Armstrong"), a certified Competitive Local Exchange Carrier serving portions of Kentucky, was made aware of an Order in the above matter by the Commission that was issued on May 30, 2012. This order purportedly requires a telecommunications company in Kentucky to file revisions to its Switched Access Tariffs as a result of the FCC Report and Order in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. FCC Release 11-161 (November 18, 2011). The Order also seems to require that these revisions be filed by June 1, 2012. Armstrong did not meet this deadline.

While we at Armstrong believe it would be impossible to revise our Switched Access Tariffs on two days' notice, the fact that we were not notified by the Commission of the subject Order made it impossible to comply with the Order. Frankly, we became aware of the Order late on June 1, 2012 through discussions with a third party. Given the date and time of our becoming aware of the Order and its requirements, we obviously could not prepare required revisions.

Be advised that Armstrong is in the process of preparing the revised tariff and analysis and will file the revised tariff when this is completed, hopefully by the end of this week. Since Armstrong was not served notice of the Order (or any of the proceedings leading to the Order), we request that the Commission provide Armstrong with additional time to make this filing. Further, we would request that the Commission waive the mandates of item 3 in the Ordering Section of the Order which provides as follows:

3. Any carrier failing to file the required data in ordering paragraph 1 will be presumed to have failed to properly reform its rates in accordance with the USF/ICC Order and, as a result, the intrastate access rates shall be null and void as of July 3, 2012, pending a full investigation of the rates and supporting data.

We appreciate your consideration and are hopeful that under the above-described circumstances the Commission will grant our requests. We do understand, after further investigation, that the Order may be stayed, revoked or modified and, if such occurs, Armstrong would comply with such action.
