



LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX RATE AND ESTABLISHING THE RATES THEREFORE AND ADOPTING THE CAMPBELL COUNTY PROPERTY VALUATION ADMINISTRATOR'S ASSESSMENT ON SAID PROPERTY AND PROVIDING FOR A TAX LIEN AGAINST ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF BELLEVUE TO SECURE THE PAYMENT OF SAID TAXES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Said lien shall exist and shall be enforceable for a period of ten (10) years from the date of assessment and shall not, during such period be defeated or cease to exist except by the payment of said tax. 


