**MOTION OF LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

TO SUBMIT THE CASE FOR DECISION ON THE RECORD**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) (collectively “Companies”) hereby move the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to decide all of the issues presented in this case on the basis of the record as filed, including the Rebuttal Testimonies of David Huff and Michael E. Hornung being filed contemporaneously herewith.

The procedural schedule the Commission prescribed in its May 20, 2011 Order in this proceeding has now come to an end. The Commission Staff and several intervenors have asked of the Companies, and the Companies have responded to, multiple sets of data requests. Several intervenors submitted testimony, and the Companies, as the parties bearing the burden of proof in this case, have now submitted rebuttal testimony. No members of the public have filed comments or indicated an interest in doing so, and no party to this proceeding has expressed a desire to hold a hearing.


On the basis of the record as it stands, including the rebuttal testimony, it appears there are no material factual disputes remaining; all that remains is for the Commission to consider and weigh the evidence, and to decide the merits of the issues in this case. For that reason, the


