

The average bill for water service based on 4,000 gallons will increase from \$29.64 to \$32.54, an increase of \$2.90 or 10 percent. The minimum bill of 2,000 gallons will increase from \$16.92 to \$18.60, an increase of \$1.68 or 10 percent.

The motion shall be submitted to the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Blvd., P.O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.
