PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on June 29, 2012, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") a request for an adjustment of its rates and charges to become effective on and after August 1, 2012, subject to the "Stay-Out" Commitment in Article I.1.1 of the Settlement Agreement approved in September 30, 2010 Order in Case No. 2010-00204, under which the change in rates may be filed with the Commission during 2012, but not take effect before January 1, 2013.

The proposed rates reflect a proposed annual increase in revenues of approximately 6.5% to KU.
