table, pay few prescriptions they need.

This includes many children and
senior citizens that live with family.

The worst fears, Parents have and
especially mothers are their children doing
without food, clothing prescriptions and
school supplies - where their children
will be made fun or teachers embarrassing
them, because they cannot get their school
supplies or dress correctly

I know you have heard citizens living
on a limit incomes, with many health
problems and costly prescriptions -
They have to make a choice, either
do without or pay bills like the Gas &
Electric to keep warm, fix their food,
or pay for their prescriptions -
Now the Gas and Electric are next
asking for 5c & to 1.00 increase, they
want a \$1.00 increase.

Kentucky and elsewhere in Kentucky.

I myself live on my Social Security and
90.12 pension each month and by the
end of the Month, I am struggling to
be sure I have everything paid, if I want
