This letter is in opposition to the proposed LG&E rate structure currently under review with the Public Service Commission, case 2012-00222. The proposal is to raise the flat monthly customer service charge.

While I understand the cost of maintaining infrastructure, this proposal penalizes those that have paid for energy efficient measures in their home. It also does not promote energy efficiency and renewables in Louisville. Raising the monthly customer service charge to \$13 is counter productive to sending a green message.
