**BEN TAYLOR AND SIERRA CLUB'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
OBJECTIONS AND RESPONSES TO BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION'S  
FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO SIERRA CLUB AND RESPONSES TO  
THE COMMISSION AND KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL UTILITY CUSTOMERS' FIRST  
REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION TO SIERRA CLUB**

Intervenors Ben Taylor and Sierra Club (collectively "Environmental Intervenors") request an extension of time to file Objections and Responses to Big River Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") First Request for Information and Responses to the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers', Inc. ("KIUC") First Requests for Information to Sierra Club. Under the June 19, 2012 Order in this matter, Environmental Intervenors responses to requests for information were due by August 6, 2012. Environmental Intervenors hired a copy service in Frankfort, Kentucky to handle this filing. On the morning of August 6, 2012, Environmental Intervenors sent to the copy service all of the filings and associated attachments for the responses to Big Rivers, the Commission, and KIUC's First Request for Information. 
