"CSAPR" means the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule promulgated by the EPA on August 8, 2011, and any amendments thereto

"CSAPR" means the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule, issued in final form by the EPA on July 6, 2011, to achieve reductions of sulfur dioxide ("SO2") and nitrogen oxides ("NOx") emissions in the eastern United States, and as may be amended from time to time.
