I am reviewing some agreements for CSAPR trades and have conflicting dates provided by different counterparties. Could you please tell me what is correct? Thanks

"CSAPR" means the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule promulgated by the EPA on August 8, 2011, and any amendments thereto

"CSAPR" means the Cross-State Air Pollution Rule, issued in final form by the EPA on July 6, 2011, to achieve reductions of sulfur dioxide ("SO₂") and nitrogen oxides ("NO_x") emissions in the eastern United States, and as may be amended from time to time.
