What happens to allowances if a unit does not operate, is in reserve shutdown or is retired?

Per the CSAPR write-up, a unit that "does not operate" for 2 consecutive years will lose those allowances after year 4.

As an example, if Reid 1 shuts down December 31 this year, we would receive allowances thru 2015, but

not after that year.

It does not address situations where units may run a very limited amount of time each year. I think we should run Reid 1 in January, then put it in reserve shutdown until we determine our long term approach
