SUPPLEMENT NO. 1 TO INTERCONNECTION AGPEEMENT DATED APRIL 1, 1968

THIS AGREFMENT, made and entered into and to become effective July 1, 1968, by and between BIG RIVERS RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS POWER COOPERATIVE and HENDERSON MUNICIPAL POWER & LIGHT, which supplement shall become a part of, and be incorporated in, the Interconnection Agreement previously executed by the parties and Hoosier Energy Division, Indiana Statewide Rural Electric, Inc.

::WITNESSETH::

WHEREAS, Southern Illinois and Eig Rivers and Henderson Municipal Power and Light and Eig Rivers Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation had previously contracted for sale and purchase of power in contracts previously executed on June 25, 1965, and September 1, 1965, respectively; which contracts were voided and superseded by the Interconnection Agreement dated April 1, 1966; and

WHEREAS, the previous contract provided for the sale and purchase of interin power between the parties by proper written tenders for the purchase of, and acceptance of, the same by the affected parties; and

SEMERAS, tenders had been previously executed Latween

Big Mivers and Couthern Illinois Fower and purchase by Big Rivers

of 10 MW of Interim Capacity commencing July 1, 1963 and tenders had been previously executed between Big Rivers RECC and Henderson Municipal Power & Light providing for the sale by Henderson and purchase by Big Rivers of 13 MW of Interim Capacity commencing July 1, 1968; by which mutual agreement between Big Rivers and Henderson was revised to provide for 7 MW of Interim Capacity commencing September 1, 1963; and

WHEREAS, by oversight no providion was made for the transactions between the parties hereinabove mentioned for the tenders
and sale and purchase of Interim Capacity in the Interconnection
Agreement and the parties now desire to supplement the Interconnection Agreement for the purposes of re-affirming the Agreements mentioned hereinabova.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree that the Interconnection Agreement dated April 1, 1968 will be supplemented to contain the following provisions for the sale of and purchase of interim power as hereinafter provided.

1. Southern Illinois will sell, and Big Rivers will purchase, 10 MW of capacity with all associated energy as required by Big Divers. Delivery shall occamence on July 1, 1968 and continue through June 30, 1969. Delivery by Southern Illinois shall be as scheduled by Big Rivers to the points of interconnection as contained in Exhibit A of the Interconnection Agreement. Compensation shall be the same as provided for in Article 9.01 'Compensation for Equalization Power and Energy' of the Interconnection Agreement.

2. Renderson will sell, and Big Rivers will purchase, 7 MW of capacity with all associated energy as required by Big Rivers. Delivery shall commence on September 1, 1968 and continue through August 31, 1969. Delivery by Henderson shall be as scheduled by Rig Rivers to the points of interconnection as contained in Exhibit A of the Interconnection Agreement. Compensation shall be the same as provided for in Article 9.01 "Compensation for Equalization Power and Energy" of the Interconnection Agreement.

All of the terms and conditions contained in the Interconnection Agreement shall apply to this Supplement No. 1 to the Agreement aforesaid and this Supplement shall become a part of, and incorporated in, the Interconnection Agreement as if the same had been fully existed therein prior to execution thereof.

This Agreement is subject to the approval of all regulatory bodies having jurisdiction thereof.

IN WITNESS WHIRZOF, the parties have caused this Supplement No. 1 Agreement and the Interconnection Agreement have hereunto set their hands on the day and year first above written.

Re: Legal Opinion - Supplemental changes in Interconnection Agreement

Dear Bill:

Reference is made to your recent request for a legal opinion as to the necessity of official approval by resolution of the Board of Commissioners for minor changes of the Interconnection Agreement in regard to interim power. I call your attention to KRS 96.530, as amended, which states in part as follows:

"...The Utility Commission shall have absolute control of the plant in every respect, including its operation and fiscal management and the regulation of rates, except that in fixing rates the commission shall be governed by the provisions of KRS 96.430..."

With the exception of the issuance of bonds or the application of surplus revenues, the day to day management of the plant, including the sale of power, is subject to the control of the Utility Commission, in my opinion. Therefore, I see no necessity to require the approval of these supplemental agreements by the Board of Commissioners.
