Mr. Miller:

I received a message that you had called regarding the status of Breathitt County Water District's Application in the above-referenced case. I was out of the office most of this day. I have attempted to contact you by telephone a few minutes ago, but no one answered.

Currently, the Breathitt District's application has not been accepted for filing. It fails to comply with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(f) in that it fails to contain an estimated cost of operation after the proposed facilities are completed. A deficiency notice should be sent to Breathitt District within the next two days. To avoid the issuance of the deficiency notice, I respectfully suggest that you submit a letter to the PSC in which you provide the omitted information. If you wish to submit by e-mail, you may send to me and I will ensure the material is filed in the case record.

Since the filing of the application, Commission Staff has obtained all Division of Water records related to the proposed project and will be filing those records in the case record within the next seven days. After the filing of that material and the material noted above, final action should occur within 30 days.
