ORDER

On August 17, 2012, Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) filed a motion requesting that the partial procedural schedule established by the Commission’s Order entered August 7, 2012 be amended to delay the date by which intervenors are to file testimony or comments. The motion states that LG&E and KU have negotiated with East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“East Kentucky Power”) to resolve certain discovery issues, that East Kentucky has agreed to provide LG&E and KU the hourly generation dispatch and load forecast output data produced by its consultant, Charles River Associates (“CRA”), and that the data will not be available until September 7, 2012. The motion further states that LG&E, KU, and East Kentucky Power have agreed that the due date for intervenors to file testimony or comments should be extended until two weeks after East Kentucky Power provides the CRA produced data.

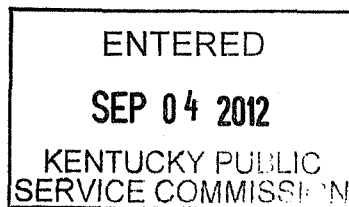
Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the request to delay the due date for intervenors to file testimony or comments is reasonable and should be granted. Since East Kentucky Power is not certain that the

agreed to data can be provided to LG&E and KU by September 7, 2012, we will allow East Kentucky Power up through September 12, 2012. Any testimony or comments by intervenors will be due two weeks later, which will be September 26, 2012. The Commission will at this time also establish dates for additional procedural events as set forth in the Appendix to this Order.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
