This is a request for intervention, by your office, to oppose and deny any rate increase by Kentucky Utilities. I am not represented by the KY Attorney General.

Kentucky Utilities request for a rate increase should be denied and dismissed. They just had a rate increase the year before last, and service has not improved. The Utility Companies have behaved like pigs at the trough, repeatedly requesting rate increases every other year.

The two main reasons to deny them are:
1.) They have given insufficient reason for any increase. Their only motive is to increase profits, to keep investors happy.

State agencies should be used to provide profits for an essential public utility.

2.) The rate increase is discriminatory towards disabled people, who are on a fixed income. Kentucky Utilities has a history of discriminating against the disabled, such as their 3-day bill increase policy at the beginning of each month. Discriminatory practices violate Federal Law.
