ORDER

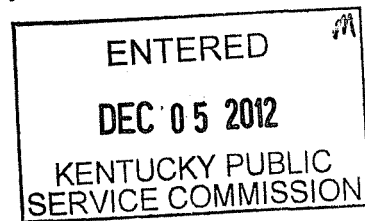
On December 3, 2012, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") filed a motion for rehearing of the Commission's Order of November 30, 2012. In support of its motion, Kentucky Power stated that the November 30, 2012 Order included an amended procedural schedule. Kentucky Power states that it does not object to the Commission's granting Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson RECC") additional time to serve requests for information, but requests that the Commission revisit certain deadlines imposed in the amended procedural schedule. Specifically, Kentucky Power argues that the amended procedural schedule does not specify deadlines for Grayson to respond to requests for information issued to it by Commission Staff and Kentucky Power. It states that the original procedural schedule called for Kentucky Power and Grayson to respond to requests for information simultaneously. Kentucky Power requests that the amended procedural schedule be

revised to allow for simultaneous filings of all responses to requests for information and that the deadline for such responses be extended to January 3, 2013.¹


Based on Kentucky Power's motion, the evidence of record, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power's motion should be granted and that the procedural schedule should be revised to allow for the deadline for all responses to requests for information issued by Commission Staff, Grayson RECC, or Kentucky Power to be extended to January 3, 2013.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kentucky Power's motion for an extension of time for the filing of all responses to requests for information issued by Commission Staff, Grayson RECC, or Kentucky Power is extended to January 3, 2013.
