Marathon Petroleum Company LP and the Catlettsburg Refinery have been analyzing the Kentucky Power Tariff R.T.P. and been in negotiations with Kentucky Power for many months with the intent to move the majority of the Catlettsburg Refinery load to Tariff R.T.P. effective July 1, 2012. I am aware that Tariff R.T.P. must be updated annually with new capacity costs or changing transmission rates, etc. However, I've just been notified that Kentucky Power is going to file to withdraw the current Tariff R.T.P. and replace it with a **newly structured RTP rate** on June 11 to be effective on July 1, 2012. While I have not seen this newly structured RTP rate, I am concerned that it will not fit our Catlettsburg Refinery load profile. While no-one has been on Tariff R.T.P. in Kentucky Power's utility territory in the past, please let it be known that Catlettsburg was planning on using this rate effective July 1, 2012.

If Kentucky Power files to withdraw Tariff R.T.P., Catlettsburg would like to object and intervene in a contested case for this withdrawal, so we would request that this potential withdrawal be set up as a contested case.
