ORDER

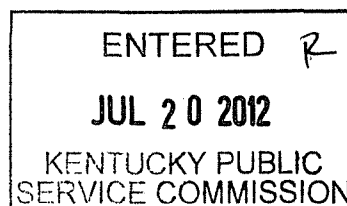
On July 13, 2012, Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) filed, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, a petition for leave to deviate from the filing requirements in this proceeding. Kentucky Power’s petition requests that it be excused from filing paper copies of its response to the initial requests for information of Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (“KIUC”) as the supporting documentation for that response to KIUC 1-1 is 653 pages. It states that producing an original response along with paper copies to the parties and six paper copies to the Commission is unduly burdensome. In support of its petition, Kentucky Power states that as a means of addressing the voluminous nature of the filing, the Company requests leave to deviate from the Commission’s June 28, 2012 Order by filing a paper “original” with the Commission, by serving paper copies on the parties of record, and submitting ten electronic copies to the Commission.

Based on a review of the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power has shown good cause to deviate from the provisions of the June 28, 2012 Order that require the filing of six paper copies with the

Commission. The Commission finds that the response to the aforementioned request for information is sufficiently voluminous to allow Kentucky Power to deviate from the June 28, 2012 Order to the extent that its petition should be granted, that it should file an original in paper medium with the Commission, serve paper copies on parties of record, and submit ten electronic copies to the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kentucky Power's petition to deviate from the filing requirements of the June 28, 2012 Order is granted to the extent that it may file an original in paper medium with the Commission, serve paper copies on parties of record, and submit ten electronic copies to the Commission.
